

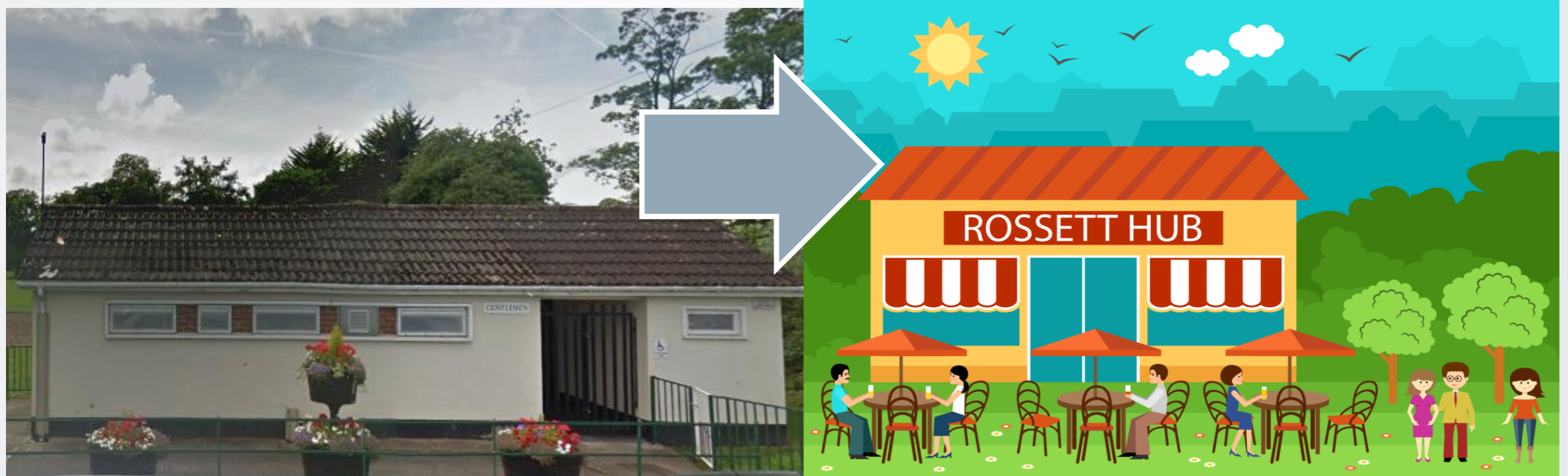

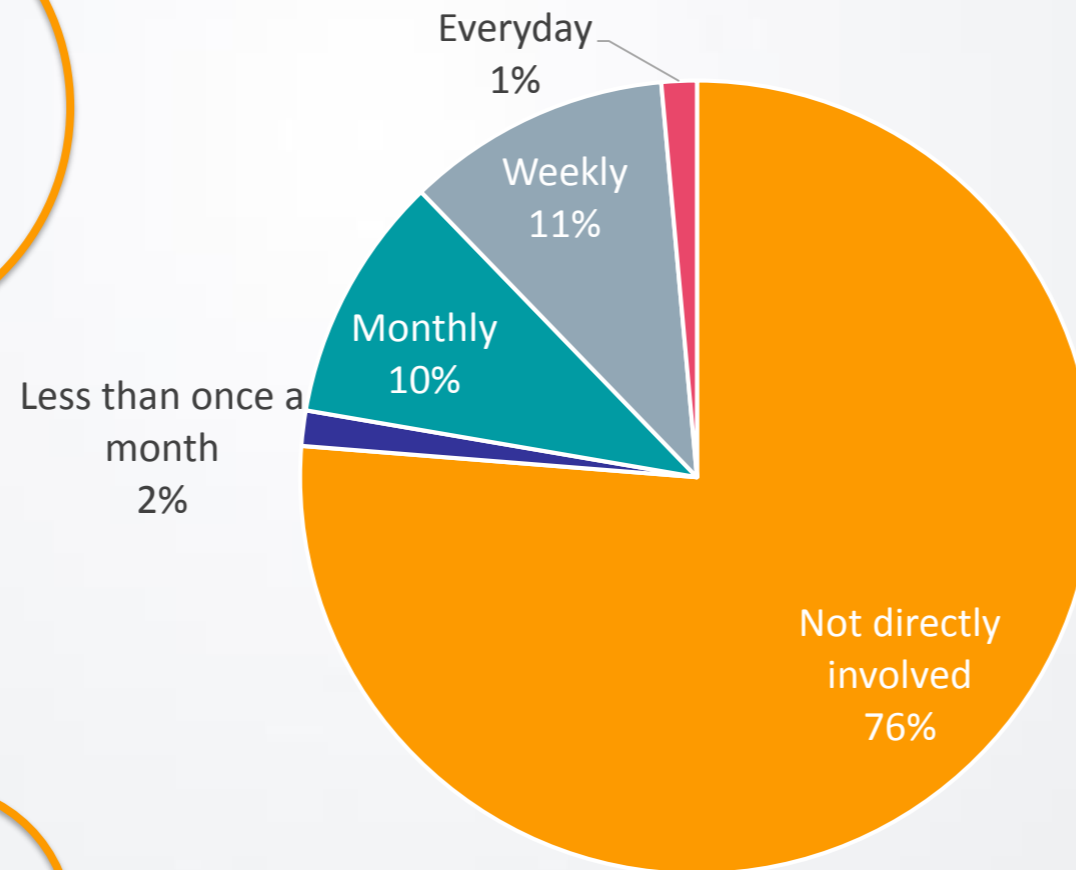
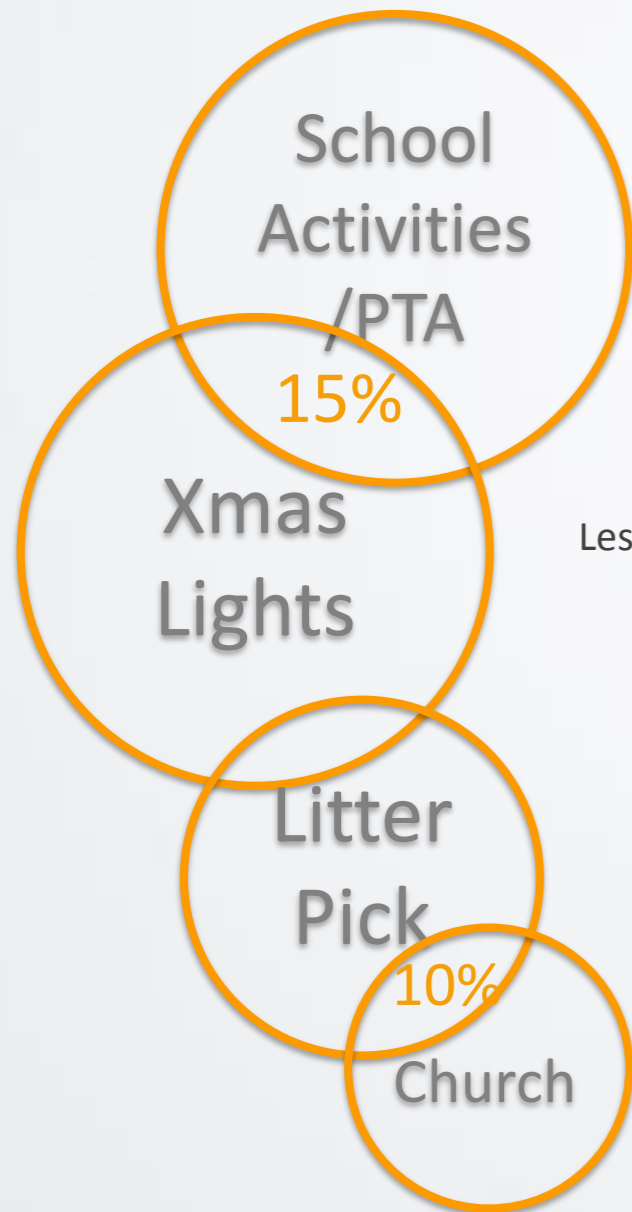

Engagement in Community Activities



Age **36-45** most likely to be involved in community (27%)

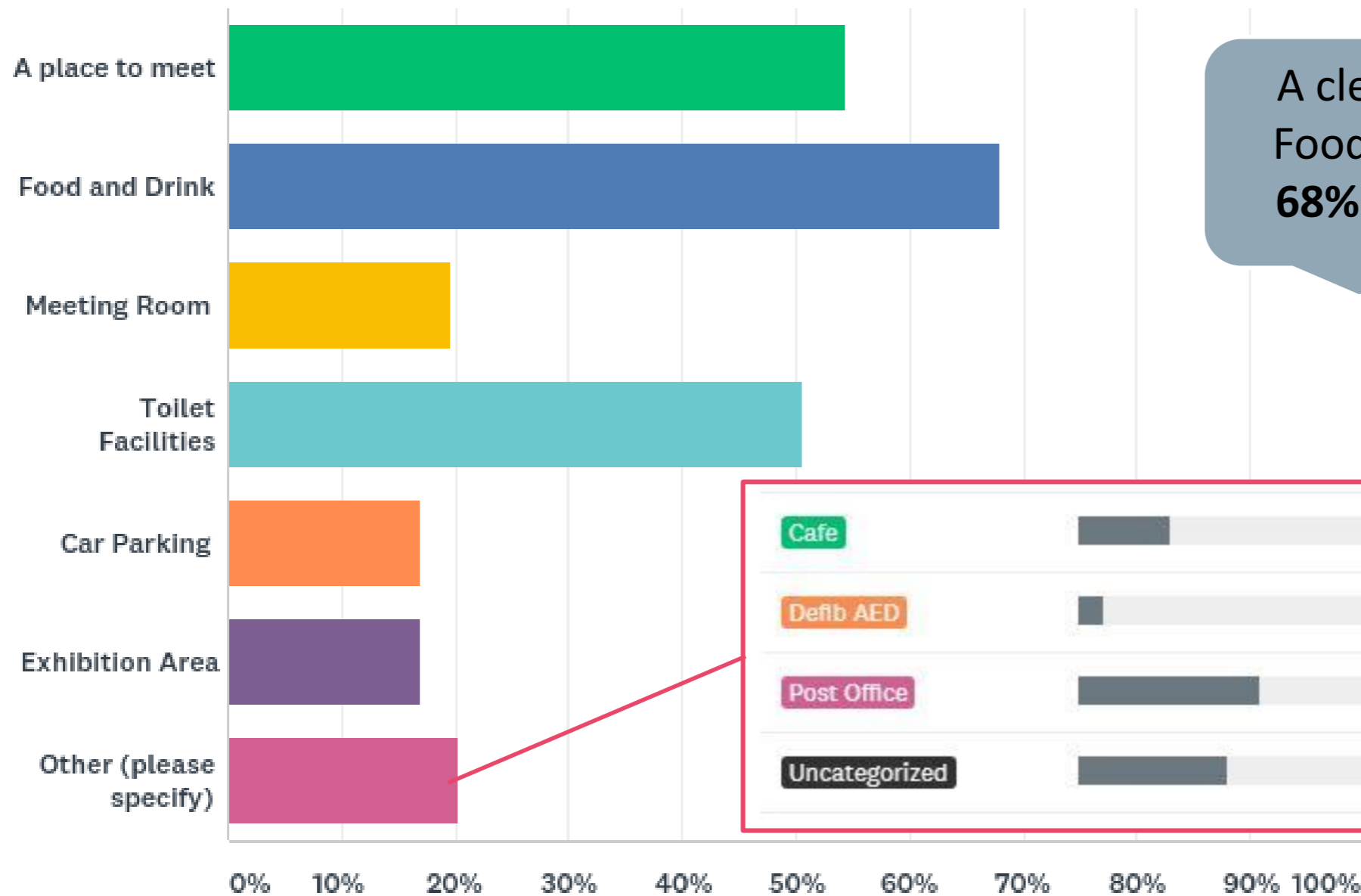
24% directly involved in community activities

Of those involved in the community, **23%** are age 66+ and **17%** age 56-65

Facilities at the 'hub'

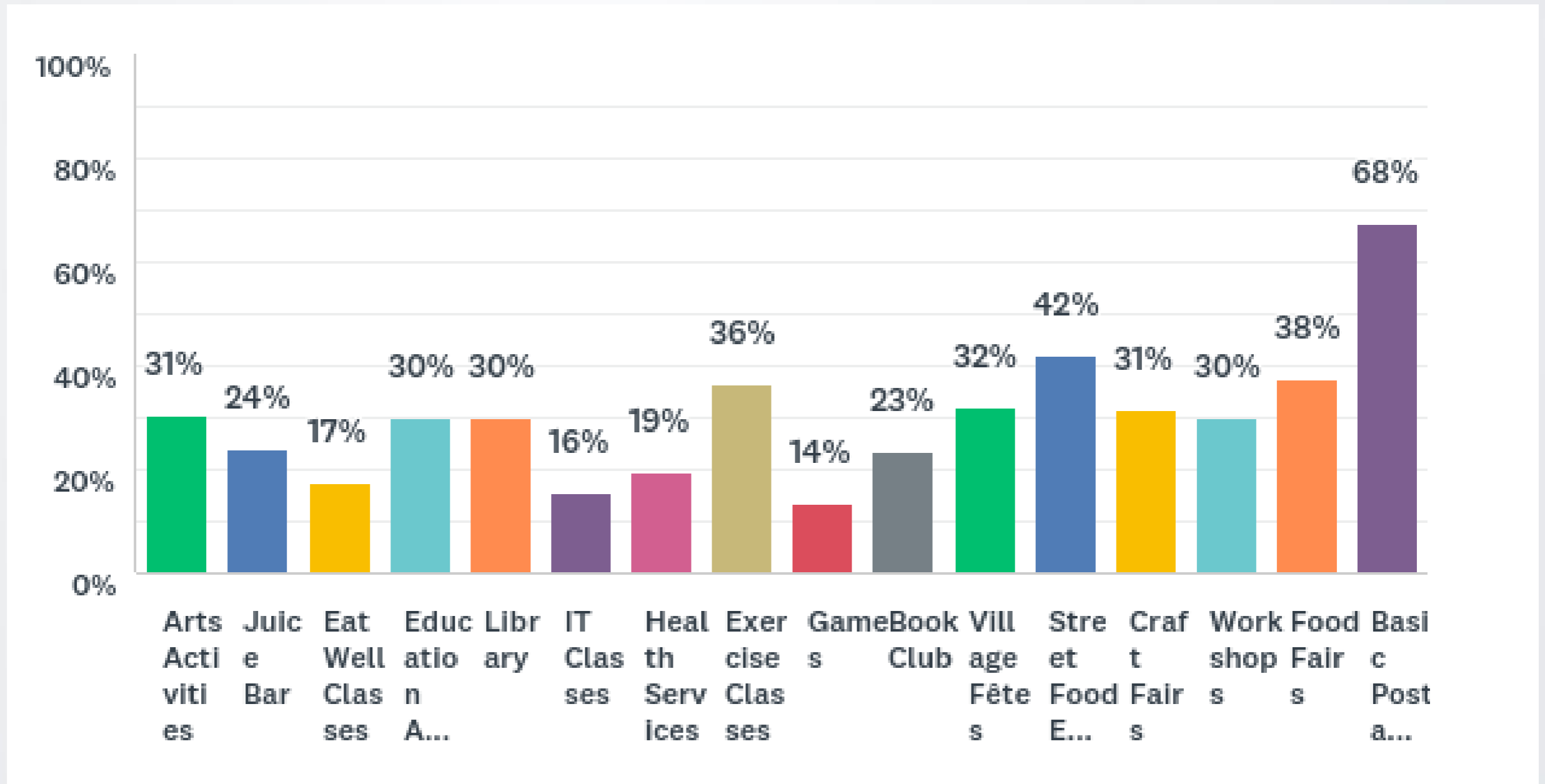


A clear favourite for Food and Drink with **68%** of respondents

Activities at the 'hub'

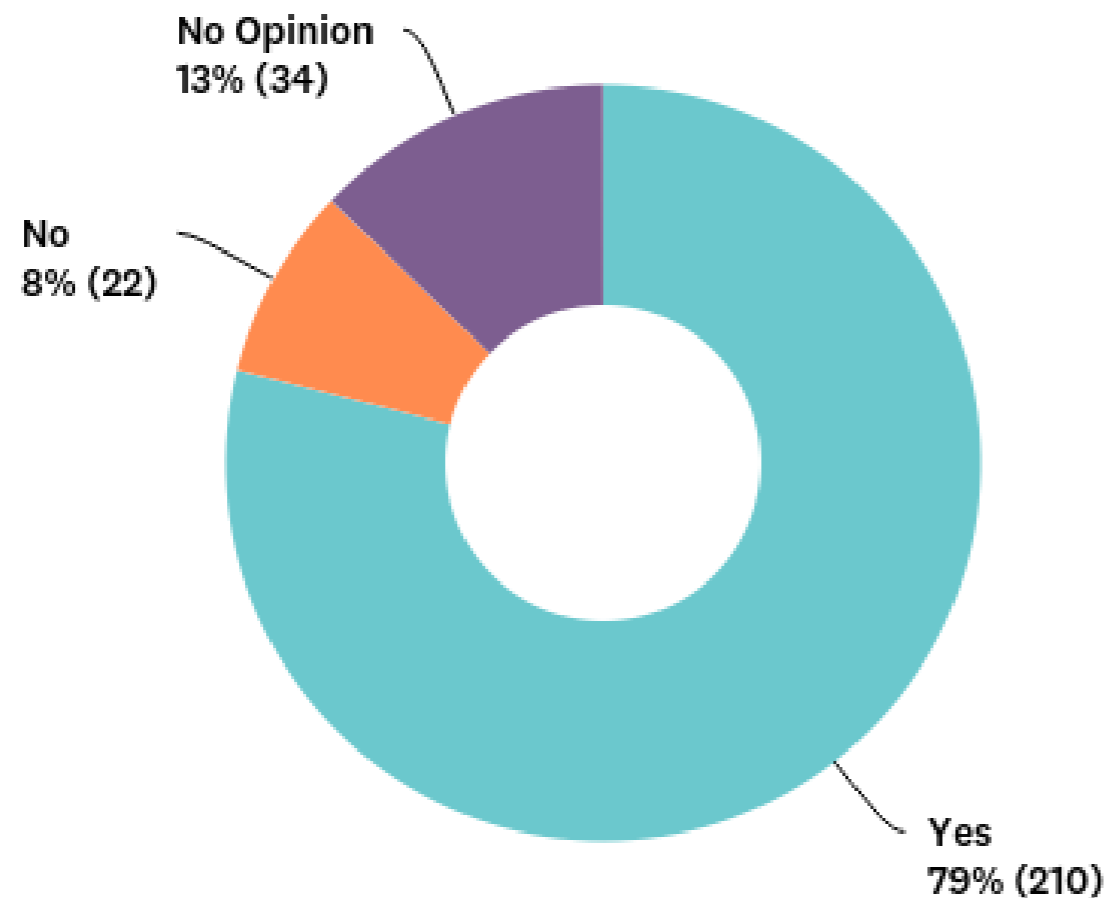


OUTCOME:

From those who responded the percentage selecting yes in each age category:

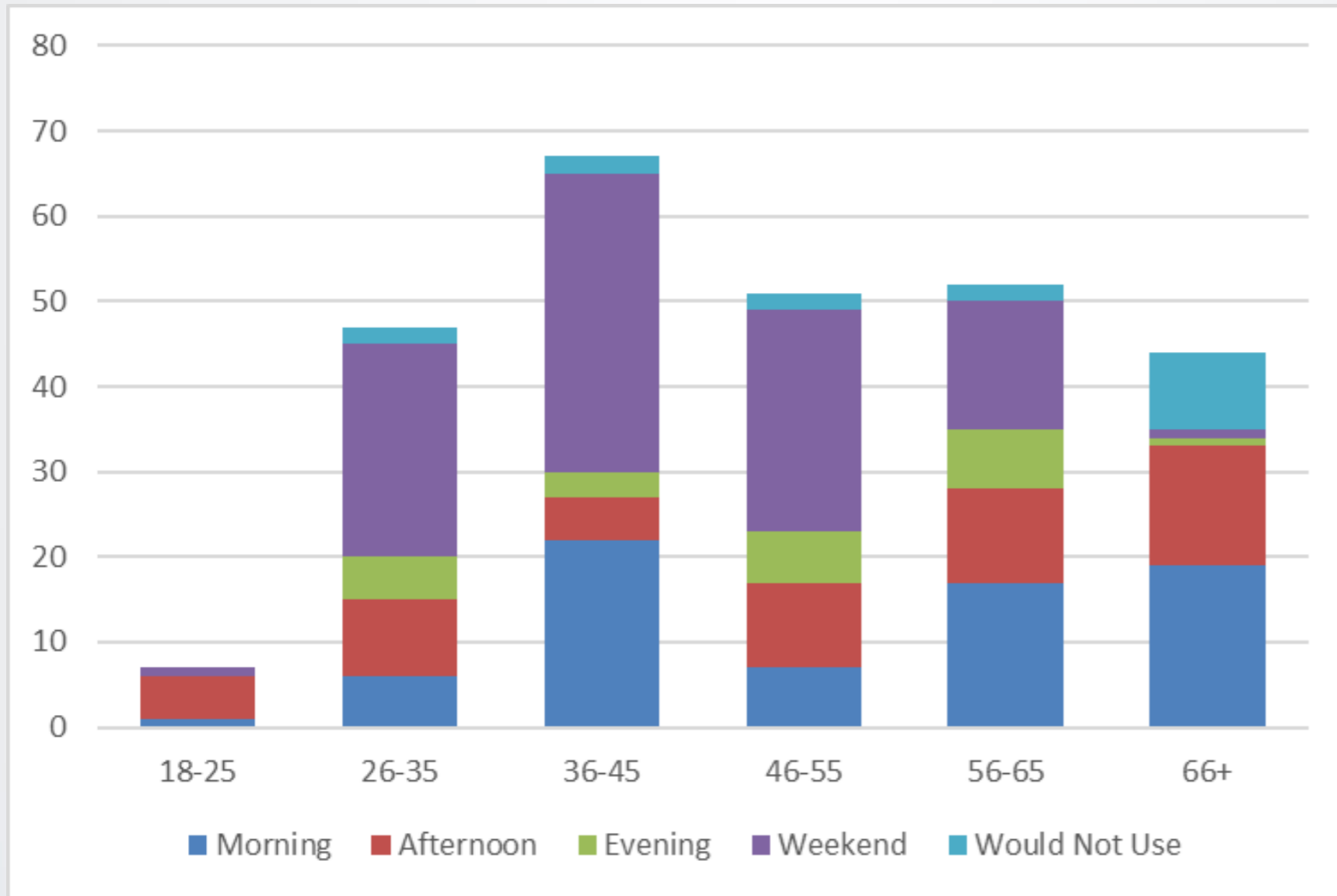

Households with Children most likely to use on Weekend

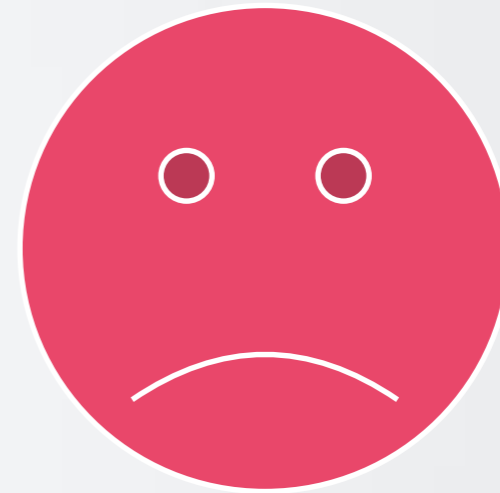
85% of households with children likely to use the hub.
