- 6. Applications to be added to the Register of Electors in order to vote at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Office below on **Tuesday**, **16 April 2024**. Applications can be made online at www.gov.uk/register-to-vote.
- 7. Electors and their proxies should take note that all applications, amendments or cancellations for new and existing postal votes must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Office below by 5pm on Wednesday, 17 April 2024. This includes electors or their proxies who wish to make alterations to their existing arrangements on a permanent basis.
- 8. Applications to appoint a proxy must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Office below by **5pm on Wednesday, 24 April 2024**.
- Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this
 election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer (as shown below) by 5pm on Wednesday, 24
 April 2024. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate can be made online www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate.
- 10. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work / service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer (as shown below) by 5pm on Thursday, 2 May 2024. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday, 24 April 2024. To apply on the grounds of work / service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday, 24 April 2024.
